STW has launched a pesticide amnesty scheme in the
Wye Catchment in Herefordshire enabling farmers and
growers to safely dispose of unwanted chemicals, pesticides and
biocides
free of charge*!

Do you qualify?

1. Check your pesticide store for unwanted or expired pesticides/chemicals
2. Check if any of your land is within the eligible catchment – see below
3. Contact ChemClear to arrange collection during the four week contact period – details overleaf



Don't delay! This is a limited offer available on a **first come, first served** basis.

Contact period- 15th February- 15th March 2018!

If you qualify for our pesticide amnesty please contact ChemClear (contact details below) during the STW four week opening period (February 15th – March 15th 2018). Please note this is the contact period not the collection period. At the end of this four week window Chemclear will assess your disposal request and arrange collection at a time that suits you. Information exchanged between landowners and ChemClear will remain confidential.

Maximum Pesticide Collection Limit per farm: 75Litres

Please have the following information available when you contact ChemClear:

- **Catchment Name and code (see table below)**
- **Product name**
- **Active ingredient and concentration**
- **Weight or volume of product in their containers**
- **Collection address & contact details for farmers - two phone numbers and an email address**
- **Maximum Pesticide Collection Limit per farm: 75Litres**

Terms & Conditions: Your farm must be located within an eligible catchment. The offer is limited to a four week window operated on a first come first served basis. The scheme is only open to farmers, growers, gamekeepers. The amnesty is not open to commercial firms engaged in waste disposal. Products acceptable for disposal under the scheme include products with either a 'MAPP', 'MAFF' or 'PSPS' or 'ACAS' or HSE registration number. Generally this will include agricultural and horticultural products approved as herbicides, fungicides, insecticides, vertebrate. If in doubt about the acceptability of your waste products, please contact ChemClear to confirm acceptability. The amnesty contact window will close at 5pm on 15th March 2018. Requests will not be accepted after this period.
